



DSST (Dantes) Examination Information

SWU score recipient code is 8135.

SWU students must receive pre-approval to take Dantes exams by completing the “CLEP / Dantes Permission” form downloaded from the SWU website, obtained from the roto-rack at the local learning center, or from their academic advisor.

The Dantes (or DSST) testing program enables colleges to award credit to students who attain passing scores on the exams and is approved by the American Council on Education (ACE). SWU awards credit based on ACE recommendations and current SWU transfer policies. SWU is not a testing center, so students must register to take exams through other colleges which offer the exams. SWU must receive the student’s official score report or transcript directly from DSST to consider awarding credit. For passing scores on acceptable exams, SWU currently charges a posting fee of \$50.00 per test. Students completing exams to meet final graduation requirements should plan to take the exam at least six weeks prior to the anticipated graduation ceremony in order to allow time for official score reports to be received.
