Southern Wesleyan University's annual golf tournament to be Oct. 17

The annual Southern Wesleyan University P.B. Wood Golf Tournament will tee off Oct. 17 at Pickens Country Club.

The tournament raises money for the Promise Fund, which supports student scholarships as well as academic and student programs. This event is named in honor of Dr. Paul Baker Wood, a noted psychologist and Southern Wesleyan University professor emeritus.

This captain's choice tournament has slots for 36 four-man teams. The fee is \$400 for a team or \$100 per player. Individual players are welcome to sign up and will be placed with a team. This fee covers greens fees, cart fees, meals, a polo shirt (or other gift) and other prizes. Hole-in-one contests with prizes totaling more than \$40,000 will also be part of the tournament.

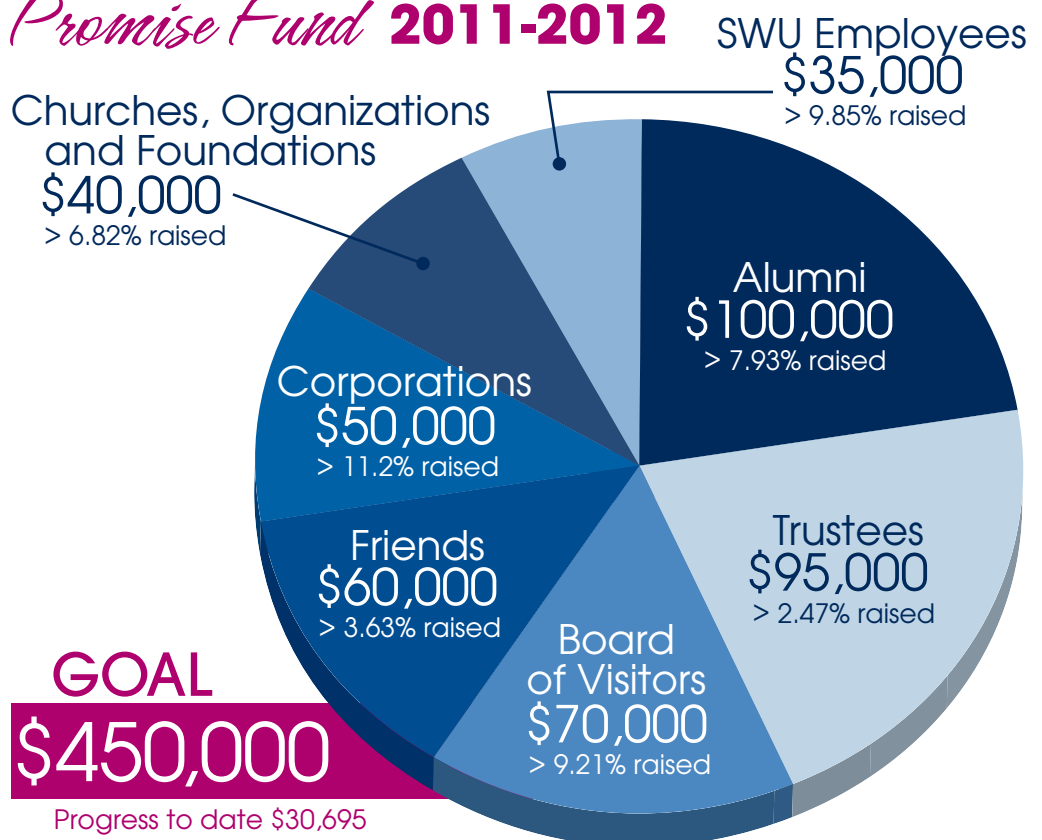
Board of Visitors to meet Sept. 29

Team SWU builds spirit, unity

The Team SWU concept began with the athletic department and Southern Wesleyan Athletic Director Chris Williams. It was started with the philosophy of “one body” bringing the 10 intercollegiate sports teams together as equals, with Christ as the central focus. By doing this, the athletic department embraces reaching out to the SWU community and bridging the gap between athletics and the campus community.

The theme verse of One Body is Romans 12:5: “So in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all others.”

“The Team SWU concept was born out of the One Body initiative,” Williams said. “We started with ourselves (athletics) and worked on supporting one another and uniting as ‘one body.’ Now we are taking it one step further to include the SWU campus, surrounding community and SWU alumni around the world. SWU and the department of athletics want to show unity and pride not just for athletics, but also

for the whole SWU community.”

Each academic year before the fall athletic season begins, the SWU Athletic Department hosts the Champions for Christ event that kicks off the Team SWU concept to the student-athletes. Williams also began what is known as SWU Blue Wednesdays, where all are encouraged to wear SWU Blue shirts.

“We have adopted a similar tradition here at SWU that Clemson fans across the United States do on Fridays of each week as they wear Clemson orange,” said Williams. “The athletic department, along with the SWU community, is asked to support the Wednesday SWU Blue Day, showing One Body support for Southern Wesleyan University.

“Wearing SWU blue is a way to show unity and pride not only for Warrior athletics but also for the whole university community,” Williams said. “By wearing SWU blue, we are honoring our university, our heritage, our sport teams, our

Golfer finishes second in Florida championship

David Brown, a sophomore golfer at Southern Wesleyan University, finished second at the 21st Florida State Amateur Match Play Championship at Southern Hills Plantation Golf Club in Brooksville, Fla.

Brown is from Eustis, Fla. and defeated the #2, #7, #15, #27 and #31 seeded players.

“I am very proud of how well David played in this event,” said SWU head golf coach Douglas Wilkinson. “It was a lot of golf for him, playing 126 holes in 4 days, and to keep winning like he did was very impressive. David has had a great summer and I am excited to see how this carries into our season.”

In the finals, Brown fell to Don Bell of Port Orange, Fla., 1 up. Bell was 3 up on Brown after 13 holes of play, before Brown won holes 14 and 16 to go into 17, 1 down. Both holes were halved with Bell making a 15-foot putt for the title on hole 18.

Brown won five matches prior to facing Bell in the championship round. Among some of his victories along the way were current NCAA Division I golfers and former Nationwide Tour players. More than 300 players attempted to qualify for this event at one of seven sites across the state of Florida.

Southern Wesleyan awarded AdvanceSC grant

SWU has received a \$50,000 grant for Chemistry Professor Pascal Binda's project entitled, "Designing new catalysts for the synthesis of polylactide polymers with enhanced degradation rate in composting environments for use in packaging applications."

This project involves designing better catalysts that allow for varying rates of polylactide decomposition according to the type of packaging. Some types of polylactide polymer, a packaging material, require longer decomposition times, while other types of packaging materials require a quicker decomposition.

The grant is awarded by AdvanceSC, a company that funds economic development projects in the Upstate.



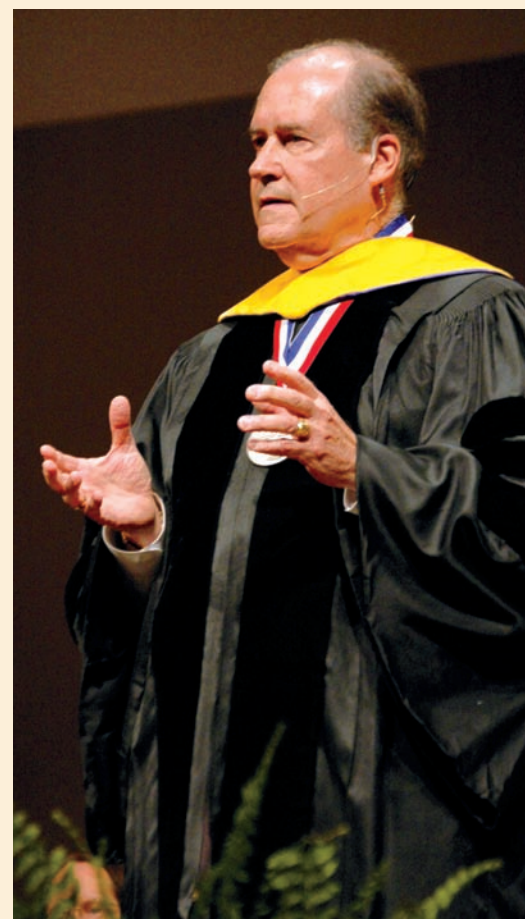

According to Binda, the grant will provide chemicals and financing for research. He said that most undergraduate students require technical skills in conducting scientific research to be successful in manufacturing industries and graduate school projects.

"Getting this funding is a huge advantage for us," Binda said. "We can carry out projects with students who are passionate about research and development in chemistry, but don't always have the resources and finances available to carry out the project."

In addition to providing first-year funding for the university's scientific research project, the AdvanceSC grant aids in promoting and developing student proficiencies for high-tech and highly skilled manufacturing jobs. Southern Wesleyan University's collaboration with Sealed Air Corporation for testing and evaluation is also an integral component of the project.

AdvanceSC supports economic development, education, manufacturing and public assistance agencies in Duke Energy's South Carolina service area. Established as a limited liability company by Duke Energy in 2004, AdvanceSC is funded with profits from the company's Bulk Power Marketing program and is managed by a board of Upstate South Carolina leaders. Dr. Karen Henderson, who teaches in the Masters of Education program

at Southern Wesleyan University, participated in a national workshop on food science, "From Farm to Table, Teachers Explore the Science Behind Nation's Food Supply." Henderson also teaches at Stephens Middle School in Toccoa, Ga., and was among 40 teachers nationwide chosen to participate in the workshop. The event took place in Washington, D.C., and was developed in a partnership among the Food and Drug Administration, the National Science Teachers Association and the Graduate School USA. The workshop is part of a program to educate teachers and students about food safety issues by exploring the science behind them.



Neil Burton, a member of Southern Wesleyan University's adjunct faculty, has been named executive director of the Michelin Career Center and Cooperative Education Program at Clemson University. Burton has been director of cooperative education at Clemson since 2008. His office is being combined with the Michelin Career Center to expand internship and co-op experiences for students. He received a bachelor's degree in journalism and mass communication from the University of South Carolina in 1989, a master's degree in English from Clemson in 1991 and a Ph.D. in educational leadership from Clemson in 2000.



Dr. Richard Rogers, Southern Wesleyan University associate professor of sociology, gave one of 19 presentations at the Penn State Stratification and Social Change Conference, which took place May 20 and 21. In one of the few studies ever on whether religion influences personal financial behavior, Rogers offered evidence that regular church attenders are likely to engage in disciplined spending, which did not necessarily result in more long-term savings, especially among conservative Protestants. The conference participants are currently working together on an edited volume to disseminate their findings to a broader audience.

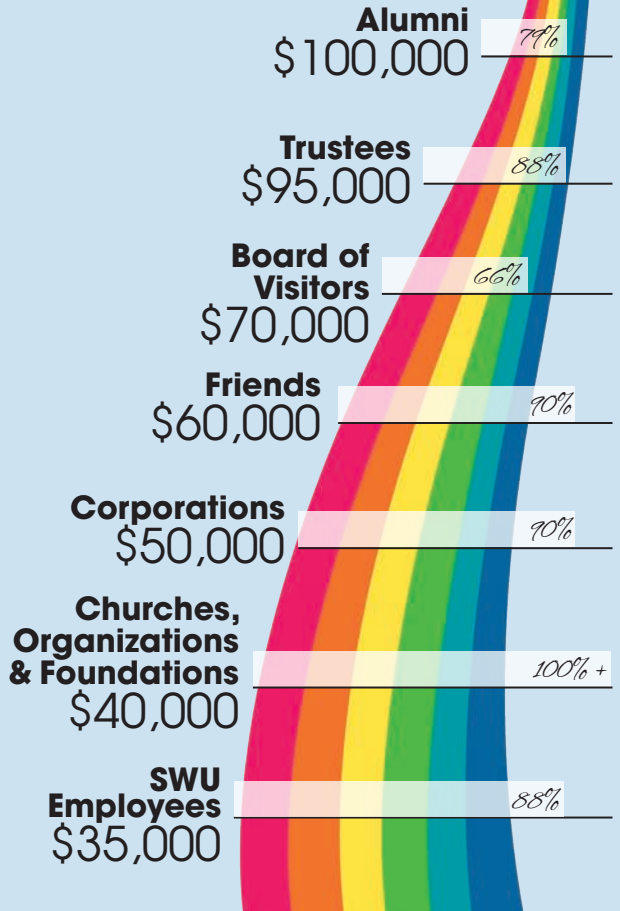

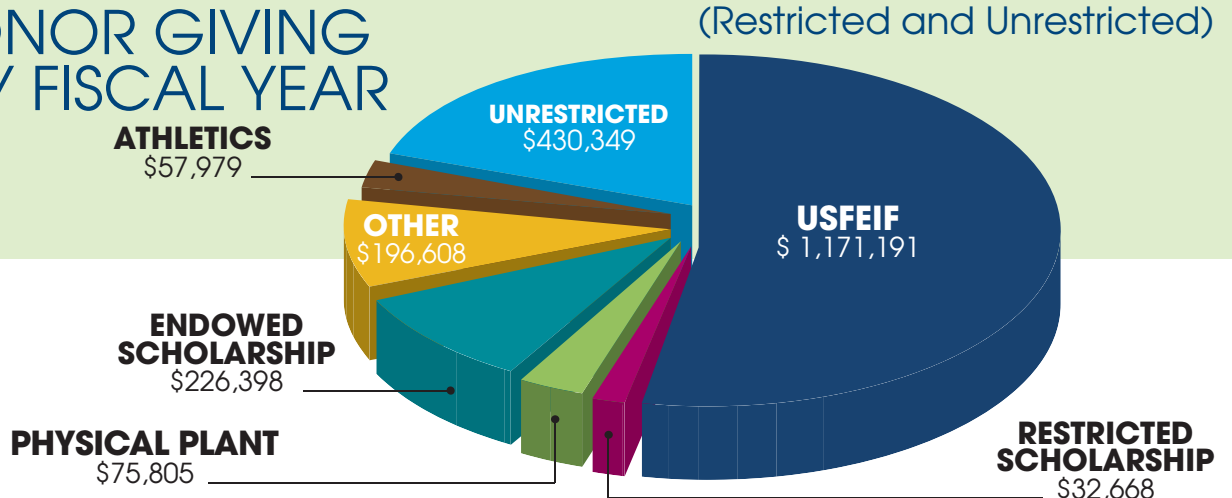
