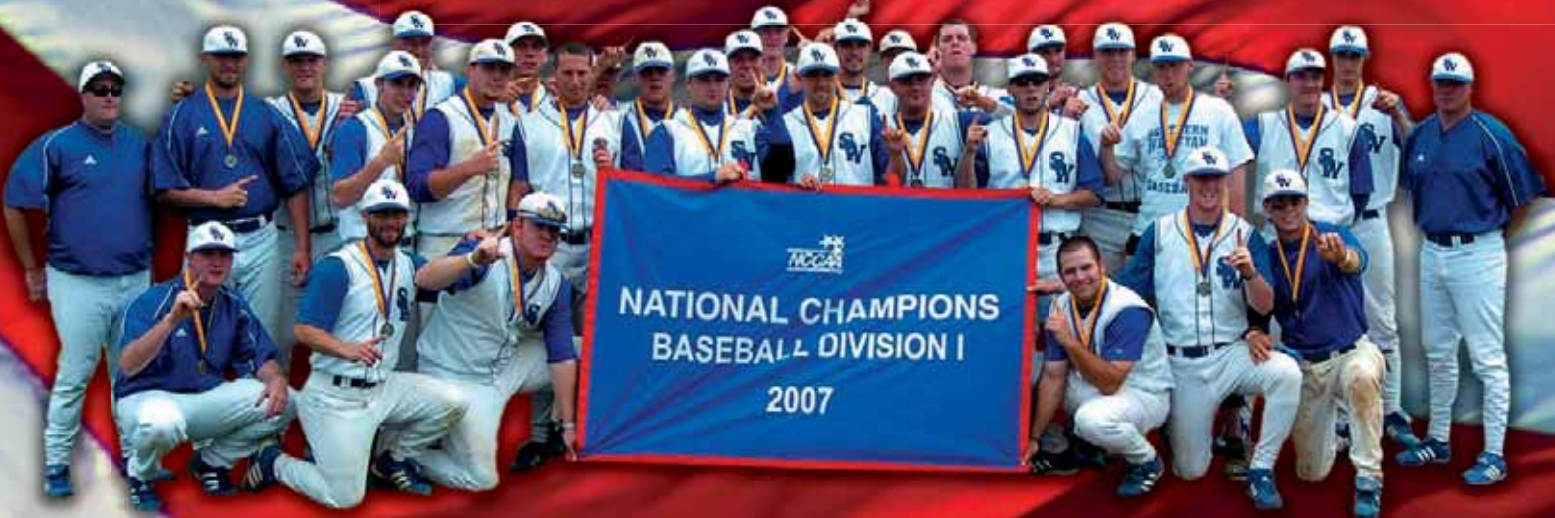

When asked to identify individuals who have influenced our lives, we often give the name of a special teacher. Even with the passage of time and faded memories, many of us seem to remember one teacher who seems to stand above the others. Time does not diminish it and perhaps even increases his or her influence and stature.

Today's teachers are the targets of criticism for all of the world's ills and for poor scores on yet another of many tests. Often teachers are blamed for poor student performance, but the same critics usually fail to cite the impact of apathetic parents and communities or to recognize the devastating impact of chronic poverty. Surrounded by this pandemic of critics, there are teachers who quietly, and without much recognition, invest themselves in the lives of their students. There is an army of

teachers who are the heroes of a new generation.

Southern Wesleyan is a teaching-centered university. As we celebrate enrollment growth, new campus facilities and expanding academic programs, the heart of our mission is found in the powerful relationship between teachers and students. Our mission statement centers our purpose on Jesus Christ and calls us to be agents of Christ for the transformation of lives.

In Deuteronomy, Moses affirms God's commands to Israel and he reminds them to fix the words of the Lord in their hearts. Moses commanded the people to treasure these words of God and, most importantly, to teach them to their children.

What constitutes a great teacher? I have discovered that truly great teachers are those who somehow teach from the heart. They seem to create a powerful connection with us that is much like learning something "by heart" and years later we rediscover these words again and again.

Those who teach from the heart truly transform lives. God has commanded us to learn from him and to learn his words "by heart." Jesus Christ came to reside within us and teach us in the classroom of our hearts. It is not coincidence that those who followed Jesus called him "Rabboni" meaning "the teacher." Perhaps that is a title we should all seek to possess.

Construction begins for chapel and fine arts center

After an April 10 groundbreaking ceremony, work is in progress for Faith Newton Hobson Chapel on the university's campus in Central.

The new chapel and fine arts center will provide seating for 1,200 in its main auditorium and will be used for student chapel programs, university and community concerts and other larger gatherings, such as community and conference events.

The three-story facility will also house offices for the university chaplain, fine arts faculty and support staff, in addition to music studios, practice rooms and rehearsal halls for the university's growing fine arts department.

The new 47,000-square-foot building is part of the university's master plan for expansion and has been designed to accommodate growth in university enrollment and to provide expanded space for community programs on the campus.

The facility is named in honor of a Southern Wesleyan University graduate. Hobson grew up near

the university and has numerous personal and family ties to the institution.

The funding for this \$6 million facility is being provided through contributions from alumni, trustees and friends of the university's

Building Foundations for a New Generation capital campaign project. Sufficient funds are in hand to begin the construction; however, the campaign is still in progress.

Construction on the new building is scheduled to be completed in August of 2008.

Businesses that can provide experience

It has been said that experience is the best teacher.

But for many Southern Wesleyan graduates who have engaged in practicums and internships with businesses, their experiences have not only served as an educational opportunity, but the key to employment after graduation.

Many programs offered at SWU require juniors and seniors to be involved in experiential learning. Practicums and internships involve placing students in businesses so they can gain experience. Both practicums and internships require 100 to 120 hours of work throughout the summer break or during the spring or fall semesters. The primary difference between the two

options is that students are paid during the internship process.

According to Dr. Keith Iddings, Southern Wesleyan University provost, practicums and internships are part of the university's academic culture.

"These opportunities are invaluable to students because the entire process involves reflection and action from the students," Iddings said. "It is ideal to place what a student is learning in the classroom into practice in these settings."

Iddings also said one of the requirements of the school's Adult and Graduate Studies program is for each student to be employed.

"The idea is that the students provide a venue for experiential learning by sharing what they have experienced in the workplace," he said.

Although the process is designed to give students "real world experience," several companies have hired interns on a permanent basis upon their graduation. Jeff Moore, dean of the university's School of Business said, "Some employers use practicums and internships as a pre-screening process for employment.

"These programs are a core component of the degrees

SWU has to offer. The premise is to get students involved in an environment within their major so they are better prepared when they graduate," Moore said.

Local companies who have provided internship and practicum opportunities for the university include Easley Custom Plastics, First Citizens Bank, Greenville Hospital System, Pickens County YMCA, Clemson Optometry and KPMG.

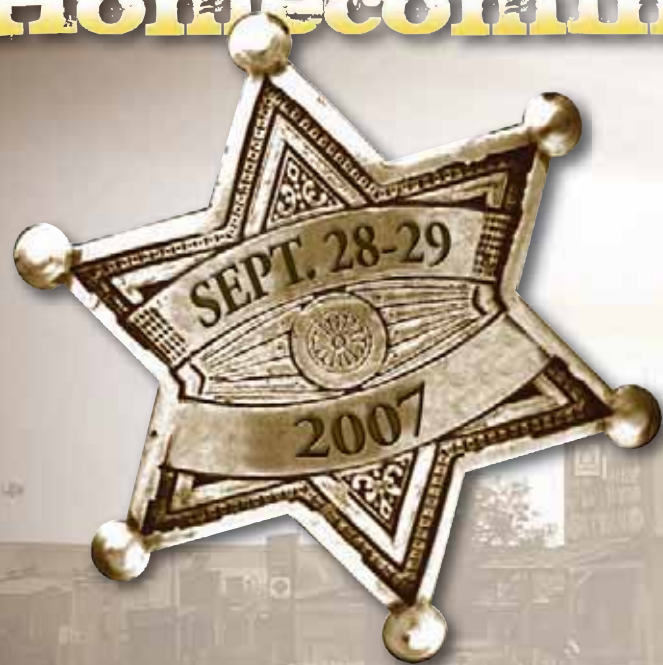

Warriors defeat Faulkner for NCCAA title

Southern Wesleyan won their fifth and deciding game of the NCCAA National Baseball Tournament in Struthers, Ohio, as the Warriors defeated Faulkner University 9-6 on May 19.

Ben Douglas picked up his second win of the series and scattered 10 hits, while allowing just three earned runs in the game. Michael Land worked the final inning to pick up the save in the championship game.

Kody Hightower had three hits in the game and scored three runs. Hightower was named NCCAA All-American earlier in the week and shared tourney MVP honors with Ben Douglas. The junior shortstop was also the key to starting the five-run rally that helped spark the Warriors to a 9-6 win after trailing 6-4.

Kellen Kmiecik, named to the All-Tournament team, had three singles, including a hit to load the bases in the rally during the seventh inning. Brandon Brown and Davey Blackburn

also collected two hits in the game to help produce the victory.

While Douglas and Hightower shared MVP honors, Kmiecik and Brandon Brown were also named to the squad for their play during the tourney. Douglas picked up two wins in the series including the first win of the tourney for the Warriors on Wednesday.

“Our guys battled all year and stayed with the theme of ‘prove it,’” said head coach Mike Gillespie. “They did just that and proved they are champions. It was a total team effort all year. I can’t express how proud and excited I am for them. What a year.”

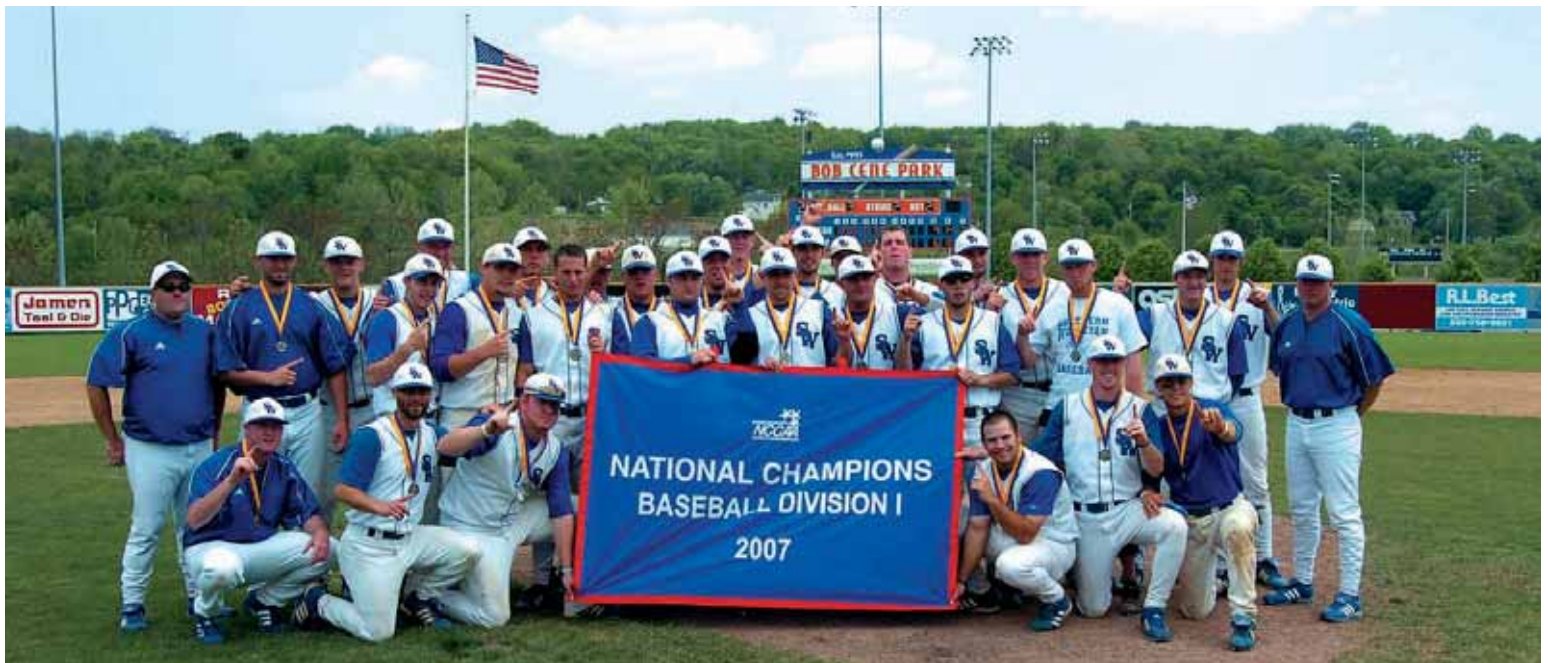

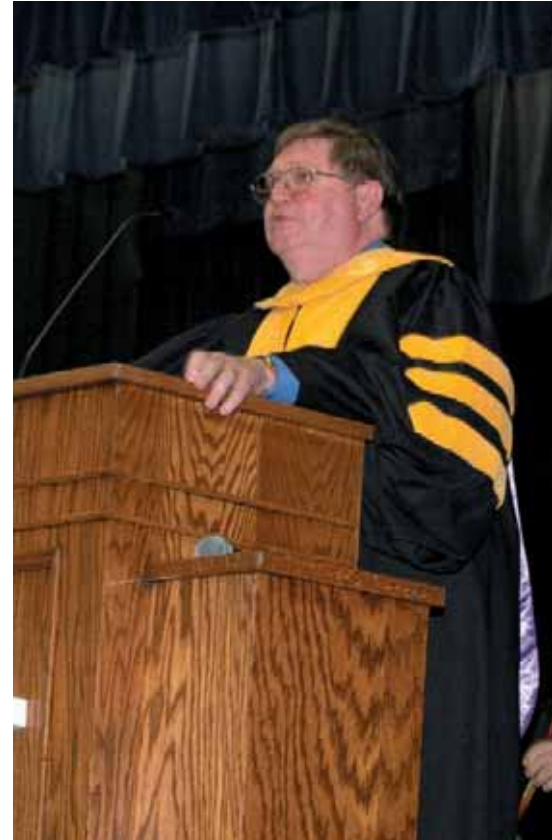


SWU convocation

Project Read *unlocks mysteries of the written word*

If you can read this, thank a teacher.

Southern Wesleyan University is helping hundreds of teachers across the state learn new ways to teach their students how to read through a program called Project Read. The project asserts: "Reading is confidence. Reading is survival. Reading is a human right."

But reading is not always easy for students. That's where the creative techniques of Project Read come in.

"I often see teachers' and students' lives change as I work with this program," said Dr. Linda Hall, state



coordinator for the Project Read grant. "Teachers who have been trained in Project Read are better prepared to teach reading and writing. At-risk students are learning to read, which helps them develop a greater level of self confidence and more positive self esteem. What better gift can you give a child than the ability to read, which changes his or her life forever?"

Hall has spearheaded the program for the past four years, with the assistance of Betty Hayes, project secretary.

Southern Wesleyan University became involved with the grant with the assistance of former state legislator Bud Webb, who helped the institution receive the statewide grant. Initially, Southern Wesleyan was allotted \$50,000 for a pilot program. Since then, Southern Wesleyan has received \$500,000 annually for Project Read.

"We are very thankful to former state representative Bud Webb for his support of this program, which makes it possible for hundreds of teachers to be trained in Project Read methodology each year," said Dr. Ray Locy, associate dean of Southern Wesleyan University's School of Education.

"We are now seeing data that indicate significant gains in the reading test scores among learners whose teachers use Project Read in their classrooms," Locy said. "It is our hope that Project Read will be

used statewide as school districts see the important impact this program can have on its learners."

The program shows teachers how to use hands-on techniques to reach students with a broad range of learning styles.

"Project Read trains language arts teachers in how to teach reading and writing," Hall said. "The program has four strands: phonology, linguistics, reading comprehension and written expression. These strands stress multisensory strategies to reach students with all learning styles. Current research says that post-secondary institutions are not teaching students how to teach reading. This program fills this gap by providing that critical training." Project Read has touched lives across the state, according to Hayes.

"We have taught more than 1,000 teachers in South Carolina," Hayes said. "The program teaches how to unlock the magic of reading for students who are having difficulty with the written word. It engages students by integrating touch, counting and other senses. It's a true hands-on education."

Teachers believe Project Read is a valuable tool, according to Dr. Fred Woodworth, dean of Southern Wesleyan University's School of Education.

“The feedback from teachers in terms of the enhancement of reading and writing skills has been overwhelmingly positive,” Woodworth said. “The School of Education is a proud collaborator with its public school partners in this effort to improve learners’ reading skills.”

Hall agrees that Project Read is

changing lives across the state. “I believe that the Project Read team and Southern Wesleyan University are serving a mission through this grant. Providing this training to teachers touches the lives of so many individuals: teachers, students and parents. This, in turn, has a positive impact on the communities in South Carolina, as well as the state as a whole,” she said.

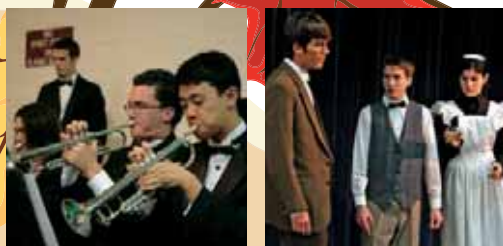
